School report, July & August

1. Teacher Professional Development

- a. After the votes of all the students and teachers, Mr. Yiu Wai Lun and Mr. Liu Chun Yat were nominated as the teachers to be honored in the 30th Parents-Also-Appreciate-Teachers Drive. They will attend the prize presentation ceremony on 26th September, 2025.
- b. Mr. Liu Shui Ka received the Outstanding Staff Award at 2024-2025 "Outstanding Staff, Enthusiastic Parents and Progressive Students" Award Ceremony of the Kwai Tsing District Federation of PTA. Thank is extended to Mr. Liu for his contribution to improving the school environment.

2. Holistic Development of students

- a. On 3rd July, the school invited a 3x3 basketball Olympic gold medal coach and members of the Hong Kong basketball team to share their experiences as athletes and demonstrate technical skills to all students. Our students also conducted an English interview with the Olympic gold medal coach, Mr. Feldmanis Raimonds, who led Latvia to win the 3x3 basketball gold medal at the 2020 Tokyo Olympics and secured the championship in the FIBA World Tour Super Final. On the event day, the gold medal coach and Hong Kong basketball team members interacted with our students, allowing them to experience professional training methods. The event concluded with a 3x3 basketball match between the coach, team members, and our school's basketball team.
- b. On 7th July, the school held the Extraordinary Achievement Celebration Party (II) to recognize students with outstanding performance and remarkable achievements in external competitions and individual accomplishments. Over 160 parents attended the event. During the ceremony, in addition to parents taking photos on stage with their award-winning children, there were also performance programs, as well as sharing sessions by the award-winning students, parents, and teachers. After the ceremony, the award-winning students, parents, and teachers participated in a celebratory tea party, enjoying a pleasant mid-day together.
- c. Congratulations to this year's graduates for their excellent secondary school placement results. On 8th July, Primary 6 students received the good news of their secondary school allocations, with 88% assigned to their first-choice school and 96% of students assigned to one of their top three preferred schools, both percentages higher than the territory-wide average.
- d. On 8th July, our school organized the "EdUHK Ping Pong @ School Education Programme." Led by Olympic table tennis medalist Li Ho Ching, a team of professional coaches and students from the Hong Kong University of Education introduced the cultural significance of table tennis as China's national sport, shared interesting stories about the sport, and taught Primary 3 students basic table tennis techniques through interactive games. During the table tennis experience, students were highly engaged, diligently learning techniques, enjoying the fun of playing table tennis, and gaining a deeper understanding of the profound cultural significance of the "national sport," enhancing their knowledge of Chinese history and culture.
- e. To encourage students to make good use of their leisure time and broaden their horizons during the summer vacation, our school organized various summer activities in July for students to participate in, including visits to the PLA Hong Kong Garrison Exhibition Centre, Ocean Park, and Disneyland. These activities provided students with a wealth of knowledge and enjoyment, as well as memorable and joyful experiences.
- f. From 17th July to 8th August, the school organized nearly 30 summer training programs, including Foreign Teacher English Playgroup, Judo Experience, Lacrosse, Fancy Rope Skipping, Gymnastics, African Drumming, Table Tennis, Football, Kendo, Basketball, Chinese Dance, Board Games, and Handicrafts. These activities covered various domains, allowing children to develop multiple intelligences and achieve a balanced physical and mental development.
- g. On 16th July, our school's English choral speaking team won the Gold Award at the 1st Hong Kong Primary, Secondary, and Kindergarten "Biliterate and Trilingual" Recitation Competition, organized by the Hong Kong Federation of Education Workers and hosted by the International Youth Art Centre. The school also received the Outstanding School Award and the Outstanding Teacher Award. On August 13, student representatives and the English subject teacher

attended the award ceremony at AsiaWorld-Expo, where they received the awards from Under Secretary for Education Dr. Sze Chun-fai and took photos with Dr. Sze and Mr. Wong Kam-leung, Chairman of the Hong Kong Federation of Education Workers.

- h. From 27th to 29th August, the school held an orientation program for incoming Primary 1 students. The students interacted with their Chinese, English, and Mathematics teachers to understand their expectations, helping them adapt quickly to primary school life.

3. Home-school Cooperation

- a. On 5th July, our school organized a PTA Parent-Child Sports Day for students from our school and Tsuen Wan Trade Association Chung Loi Kindergarten. On that day, various ball games and obstacle course setups were specially arranged, such as dodgeball, basketball, and football, allowing students to enjoy experiencing different sports with their parents while also learning various sports knowledge. During the activity, both parents and students were highly engaged, creating a very lively atmosphere.
- b. On 27th August, the school held a parents' meeting for Primary 1 students and transfer students' parents, allowing them to understand the routines of school life, learn about their children's learning, activities, lunch, and rest arrangements, and make preparations to support them accordingly.

Congratulations to Mr. Chung Kwok Wai, a parent of 5A Chung Cheuk Hin, for winning the Enthusiastic Parent Award at 2024-2025 "Outstanding Staff, Enthusiastic Parents and Progressive Students" Award Ceremony of the Kwai Tsing District Federation of PTA, and congratulating 1B HANS DILSHAN SINGH for winning the Progressive Student Award.
