Circular on the Patriotic Education and Research Activities for Young People from Guangdong, Hong Kong, and Macau

To foster patriotism among students and strengthen ties with sister schools, our school will arrange for students to participate in the "Bay Area Youth, Building Dreams for the Future" program. Through themed class meeting, workshop, and field trip, students can learn about the historical context of the Shenzhen-Hong Kong water supply and the unique charm of intangible cultural heritage such as rope art and paper-cutting. Furthermore, the program explores the design concepts and principles of local landmarks, deepening students' understanding of their motherland and strengthening their sense of national identity. Activity summary	Along with our sister school, Shenzhen Luohu Primary School, we will visit the Guangdong Water Affairs Exhibition Center, allowing students to gain a deep understanding of Shenzhen's reservoir system and experience intangible cultural heritage activities such as rope art and papercutting, enabling students to appreciate the profound and unique charm of Chinese traditional culture. In addition, we will participate in the "Harmony Playground Co-Creation Workshop" where students learn how to create physical spaces, enhancing their creativity and collaboration skills.
