School report, September

1. Teacher Professional Development

- a. The school actively promotes digital education, including artificial intelligence and robotics programming. This year, the school participates in the Quality Education Fund's thematic network programme, themed "Promoting STEAM Education through Autonomous Learning in the Era of Artificial Intelligence." It collaborates with the Learning Development Laboratory of the Department of Electrical and Electronic Engineering at the University of Hong Kong to further enhance the school's digital education.
- b. On 13th and 30th September, our school's English subject consultant, Dr. Tang Mei Sin, visited to launch this year's school-based English curriculum development plan. She will come every other week to co-plan lessons and observe classes with subject teachers, develop English teaching materials, and discuss related teaching strategies with an aim to improve the quality of teaching and learning.

2. Holistic Development of students

- a. To help Primary 1 students quickly adapt to campus life, our school launched the "Big Brothers and Big Sisters" Scheme. Senior students guide Primary 1 students to learn about the campus and routines. The program also aims to train senior students to show care and learn to look after others, working together to build a loving and positive school culture. The teachers meticulously planned for the senior students to receive guidance on how to care for their younger peers prior to the program's commencement.
- b. On 10th September, for the annual "Teachers' Day," our school made certain arrangements for students to express their gratitude and admiration for the principal and teachers. Students were encouraged to show respect and thanks through worksheets and videos. Student representatives also performed the song "Listen to Me, Say Thank You" to convey holiday greetings to the principal and teachers, appreciating their hard work and dedication to education.
- c. On 26th and 27th September, members of our school's martial arts team, Chinese drum performance team, and breakdancing team performed at the Tsuen Wan Business Community's National Day Celebration Gala, the Kwai Tsing Family Fun Day, and the National Day and Mid-Autumn Festival Celebration activities. They celebrated the National Day with the community, bringing joy to the audience.

3. Home-school Cooperation

- a. On 22nd September, our school held an indoor athletics competition for P1 & P2 students at the Tsing Yi Southwest Sports Centre. Students participated in events such as shuttle runs, standing long jumps, and beanbag tossing competitions, experiencing the joy that comes from competition and sports. Many parents came to support the students and watch the events, creating a lively atmosphere that filled every participating student with enthusiasm and energy.
