School report, October

1. Teachers' Professional Development

- a. From 13th to 17th October, Ms Lily Huang participated in the 2025-2026 Professional Training Course for Special Educational Needs Coordinators (Phase 1), co-organized by the Centre for Advancement in Inclusive and Special Education of the Faculty of Education at the University of Hong Kong and the Education Bureau. The course aimed to enhance understanding of the latest developments in inclusive education and the roles and responsibilities of coordinators in promoting the "Whole School Approach" to inclusive education.
- b. From 28th October to 1st November, Ms Leung Sze Nga attended the 2025 Hong Kong-Mongolia Sister School Signing Ceremony and Study Tour. She signed an agreement with the sister school, Binhe Primary School in Haibowan District, Inner Mongolia, to prepare for future exchange activities between the two schools. Additionally, Ms Leung visited schools (primary and secondary) in Hohhot for exchange activities and conducted study tours at the Yellow River Shenyuan Desert Base, Sai Shang Old Street, and the Inner Mongolia Museum.

2. Holistic Development of students

- a. To assist P.1 students in adapting to campus life as quickly as possible, our school has organized the "Little Master of Self-Reliance" training group for students to participate in, aiming to enhance their self-care abilities and life skills. The training includes daily routines such as writing a handbook, organizing school bags, and lining up, as well as life skills like table manners, dressing appropriately, and personal hygiene, helping students establish good habits and a sense of responsibility.
- b. On 21st of October, our school organized a visit for all teachers and students to the Hong Kong History Museum to explore the "National Security Exhibition Gallery." During the visit, students engaged with information on various aspects of national security, including viewing model exhibits such as the "Fendouzhe" (Striver) submersible, the Chang'e-6 probe, and artificial satellites. Through diverse display panels, virtual reality experiences, and interactive games, students gained a deeper understanding of the importance of safeguarding national security. This experience not only enhanced their knowledge of national security but also strengthened their sense of responsibility and mission.
- c. In order to enable students to learn the correct values related to sports, our school organized booth activities, book fairs and animations of small brown bean picture books from 21st to 24th of October. Students were also encouraged to do more physical activities and experience the emerging sport of pickleball. The students were very engaged in various activities and learned different values from them.
- d. To enhance students' understanding of Chinese culture, our school organized a four-day study tour to Beijing, China, from 23rd to 26th of October, aimed at deepening students' knowledge of the mainland's history, culture, and customs, while fostering national identity and patriotism. The tour group consisted of 32 participants, including teachers and students. During the trip, they observed the national flag-raising ceremony at Tiananmen Square, visited our sister school, Beijing No. 12 Middle School Nanzhan Campus, and explored cultural landmarks such as the Summer Palace, the Great Wall, the Forbidden City, Prince Gong's Mansion, Yandai Xiejie (Tobacco Pipe Lane), and the Beijing Stone Carving Art Museum. The experience greatly broadened the students' perspectives and was highly rewarding.
- e. The English Department organized a series of Halloween activities from the 28th to the 31st of October, enabling students to learn about Western festivals and culture while acquiring new English vocabulary and practicing English communication. On the 31st of October, students dressed in a variety of festive costumes and actively participated in the activities, demonstrating enthusiasm. This engagement enhanced their interest in learning English and improved their English listening and speaking skills.
- f. On the 30th of October, our school organized a movie screening event where teachers and students watched *Glowing Stars* together. The film, adapted from a true story, depicts the journey of a rural primary school in Guangzhou achieving the world championship in jump

rope. Through watching the movie, we aim to inspire students with positive energy, motivating them to pursue their dreams with greater determination, adopt a proactive attitude toward life, and gain a deeper understanding of the principles that "where there is a will, there is a way" and "success is earned through hard work."

3. Home-School Cooperation

- a. From September to October, our school invited parent volunteers to conduct storytelling activities, with approximately four sessions for each class in P.1 and P.2. The students responded with great enthusiasm. Several parent volunteers participated in the activities, engaging interactively with the students. The parents primarily used moral education picture books provided by the school. Following each session, students showed increased interest in borrowing books from the library, enhancing their enthusiasm for reading. Teachers reported that students were highly engaged and listened attentively to the parent volunteers' storytelling. Through questioning and lively presentation techniques, the parent volunteers helped students learn valuable lessons from the stories, further fostering their interest in reading.
- b. On 18th of October, the Parent-Teacher Association of our school held its first meeting of the academic year to discuss matters related to the activities to be organized by the association for the new school year.
