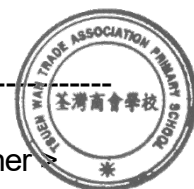

School report of November

1. Teachers' professional development

- a. From 12th to 14th and 26th to 28th November, Mr. Chow Kwan Kit joined a Mainland study tour to Changsha, and Mr. Liu Chun Yat joined a separate Mainland study tour to Zhuhai. The purpose of these visits was to acquire the latest information on educational policies and measures, thereby enabling them to apply such knowledge appropriately in their teaching practices.
- b. On 18th November, the Principal, together with eight administrative heads of subject panels and teachers, participated in the Tsing Yi District Primary Schools Joint Teacher Professional Development Day organised by the Tsing Yi District Primary School Heads Association. The school's Mathematics Panel Chairperson shared with colleagues from other primary schools in Tsing Yi District the key points of attention from the Education Bureau's Focused Inspection. At the same time, participants also listened to sharing from colleagues of other schools who had experienced Comprehensive Inspections and Focused Inspections.

2. Students' all-round development

- a. From 3rd to 13th November, the school organised the annual historical figure election activity under the theme of "History Education – Wonders & Legends of China". Through classroom teaching, information displays, study worksheets on historical figures, and comic storybooks featuring these figures, students gained knowledge of Chinese dynasties and prominent historical personages, thereby fostering a sense of identification with the nation and its people. Students showed great interest in the deeds of the historical figures and in the voting process; they also produced videos introducing the lives and achievements of their chosen figures. This activity not only allowed students to experience the electoral process but also deepened their understanding of the contributions made by Chinese historical figures to the nation and its social culture, thereby enhancing their interest in studying national history.
- b. To enhance students' understanding of string instruments and elevate their music appreciation skills, the school organized the concert entitled "Melodies Resound Far and Wide" on 11th November. During the event, the school's string orchestra performed a diverse selection of renowned Chinese and Western pieces. In alignment with the 15th National Games of the People's Republic of China, the programme also incorporated musical works related to equestrian events and sword dancing.
- c. To cultivate students' self-care and positive values, the school arranged for Suicide Prevention Services to deliver a life education talk titled "Love Others" for P.3 and P.4 students on 12th November. The talk was conducted in a relaxed and interactive manner, enabling students to learn how to care for others and treat people with kindness in a joyful atmosphere. Students participated actively and gained insights into treating those around them with friendliness, accompanying others with tolerance and encouragement, supporting one another, and progressing together.
- d. P.1 students participated in a General Studies outdoor visit to Tsing Yi Park from 13th to 21st November. Through this field-based learning experience, students gained knowledge of the various types of plants, animals, and facilities in the park, as well as the rules to be observed when using public parks.
- e. Each class organized warm and joyful birthday celebrations for students born between September and December. Teachers, classmates, and parents carefully prepared an abundance of delicious snacks, exquisite cakes, and heartfelt birthday cards to convey their best wishes to the birthday celebrants. In addition, during Birthday Week, the school specially set up a "Birthday Song Request Station," allowing students to dedicate songs as a way of expressing their blessings to their classmates.

3. Parent-school cooperation

- a. To provide students with outdoor learning activities that benefit their physical and mental well-being, as well as opportunities to experience the joys of communal living, the school organized a school outing on 14th November, with parents invited to participate. P.1 to P.3 students visited Kowloon Park, while P.4 to P.6 students engaged in outdoor learning at Pak Tam Chung Country Park. Group activities helped unite the students, playing a crucial role in their social and emotional development. Moreover, stepping outside the classroom to learn how to interact with peers in a new environment and adapt to changes were key experiences gained from the outing. All students enjoyed a fulfilling and meaningful day.
- b. To assist P.6 parents in preparing early and supporting their children's smooth transition to Secondary 1, the school organized a parent seminar titled "Preparing Your Child for the Transition to Secondary School" on 21st November. A social worker from the Social Welfare Department's North Tsing Yi Integrated Family Service Centre was invited as the guest speaker to share strategies on how parents can help their children cope with the changes of entering secondary school and embrace this new stage of life.
- c. On 23rd November, the school participated in the "Yan Chai Charity Walk 2025" held at the Art Park Great Lawn in the West Kowloon Cultural District. A total of 53 participants, comprising the Principal, teachers, parents, and students, attended the event to raise funds for the Yan Chai Tomorrow Renewal Charity Fund. The school successfully raised a total of HK\$7,351 in donations. The school extends its sincere gratitude to all parents and students for their generous contributions and enthusiastic fundraising efforts.
