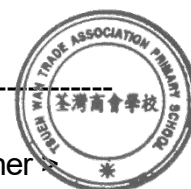

The latest developments in the school

1. The school is planning this year's study abroad tour with a tentative date for mid-April. Parents will be notified now, and a separate notice will be issued when it is implemented.
2. The school conducts a tender for lunch suppliers every year, taking the nutrition and hygiene of the same meal as the main consideration. As in the past, Parent-Teacher Association will be invited to assist in carrying out relevant work and select a suitable supplier.
3. The contract line of the school uniform supplier is about to expire, and the school not only tenders to select suitable companies, but also updates the school uniform style. Students entering the new school year will wear the newly designed uniforms, while other students can still wear the original uniforms or purchase new ones.

School report, January

1. Teachers' professional development
 - a. From 12th to 16th January, Ms. Huang Lili attended the Professional Development Programme for the Special Educational Needs Coordinators in order to further enhance the effectiveness of the support given to students with SEN.
 - b. On 6th & 27th January, our English consultant, Dr. Tang Mei Sin, conducted the lesson observation and the 8th & 9th school-based co-planning meeting which is scheduled to be held every two weeks with the English teachers to develop the school-based materials and promote the teaching strategies.
2. Students' all-round development
 - a. On 16th January, our school held a post-examination event themed "Fun Learning of Chinese Culture." Through various booth games, students reviewed basic knowledge of the Chinese language.
 - b. On 16th January and 21st January, our school held events featured a range of activities about traditional Chinese medicine, including multimedia VR experiences, practical workshops on herbal applications, herbal explorations, and a talk titled "What is Traditional Chinese Medicine?" Students were actively engaged and eager to ask questions. On 21st January, the "Extraordinary Journey of the Copper Man" event, Instructors and doctors from Beijing Tongrentang delivered a talk to students in Primary 2 and 3 about traditional Chinese medicine, covering topics such as wandering physicians, acupoints, acupuncture on the Copper Man, and the four diagnostic methods of "looking, listening, questioning, and touching." Everyone was very attentive during the presentation.
 - c. The annual Sports Day took place on 19th January at the Kwai Chung Sports Ground, with most students from Primary 3 to 6 participating in track and field competitions, enjoying the fun that competition and sports bring. Over 200 parents attended to support the students and watch the events, and parent volunteers also assisted on that day. The school hopes to instill in the children the spirit of "striving for excellence" and "remaining humble in victory and resilient in defeat" through competition. Cub Scouts, Brownies, and campus reporters, were able to serve and apply their learning during this annual event, adding more significance to it. Thanks were extended to Wai Kiu College for sending a timing team to assist in making the races effective, fast and fair.
 - d. To inspire students' interest in Earth science and exploration, our school arranged for representatives from Nina Park to visit on 22nd January, conducting a themed talk and exhibition titled "Fossil Decoding Series." Students learned more about fossils, the ecological history of the Earth, Hong Kong's geological features, and more. The students were very engaged in the activities and showed a strong interest in paleontology and fossils.
 - e. To cultivate students' teamwork spirit and enhance their leadership skills, the school arranged for Primary 5 students to participate in a 3-day, 2-night educational camp on Cheung Chau from 28th to 30th January. Through activities such as a community treasure hunt, exploration of Cheung Po Tsai's Cave, astronomy exploration, sandcastle competitions, a barbecue evening, environmental themed studies, and competitive games, students learned interpersonal skills and developed their ability to be self-sufficient and independent.

3. Home-school cooperation:

- a. To celebrate the 100 days of classes for Primary 1 students, our school, in collaboration with tChu Cheung Kindergarten, held the "100 Days Banquet " at the Panda Hotel on the evening of 16th January. That night, the school invited many kindergarten principals and teachers from inside and outside the district to attend the 100 Days Banquet and witness the growth of the children. In their finest attire, K1 & P1 students stepped onto the stage with confidence. In addition to thanking their parents and teachers for their guidance, students also presented flowers to their kindergarten teachers, showing their respect for them. Parents and teachers also discussed the students' learning progress during the event.
- b. On 30th January, the school held a charity annual flower sale organized by the Community Youth Club. Many students and parents supported the event. Potted plants were bought and donations were made to the charity.
