The latest developments in the school

1. The school successfully applied for the Quality Education Foundation " My Pledge to Act - Be grateful and treasure what we have, stay positive and optimistic", with an allocation of \$63,800, to subsidize schools to organize diversified learning activities to create a learning environment conducive to cultivating positive values and attitudes.
2. To tie in with the promotion of digital education, the school successfully applied for a one-off grant of \$500,000 under the AI for Empowering Learning and Teaching Funding Programme to support schools in procuring AI tools and resources, as well as subsidizing students to participate in activities to enhance their AI literacy and skills.

School report, February

1. Teachers' professional development

- a. From 6th to 11th February, the school arranged for Mr. Yip Kam Wah and Mr. Chow Kwan Kit to travel to Inner Mongolia for a 6-day Inner Mongolia (Hohhot) Study Tour. During the trip, the teachers engaged in constructive seminars and exchanges with various study-tour organizations and cultural tourism groups. They also conducted field inspections at the Inner Mongolia Aerospace Science and Education Research Centre and the Ulan Hada Volcano, exploring high-quality local educational resources. These efforts aim to prepare the school for expanding students' horizons and enhancing their cultural experiences.

2. Students' all-round development

- a. From 11th to 13th February, our school hosted a series of Lunar New Year celebrations to help students experience the holiday spirit and learn about its traditions. Through activities like New Year storytelling, calligraphy, traditional printing, carnival games, and a dedicated book fair, students gained a deeper appreciation for Chinese cultural heritage.
- b. On 13th February, during the Chinese Cultural Activities Day and Lunar New Year Fair hosted by Creative Kindergarten (Ma Wan) and Creative Kindergarten (Tsing Yi), our school's Junior Chinese Dance Team performed the group dance 'Zhuo Zhuo Qian Zi'. Dressed in Dunhuang dance costumes, the team gave a dedicated and outstanding performance. Furthermore, Primary 6 students Lau Kingsley and Lui Cheuk Chi participated in service learning at the Lunar New Year Fair; they hosted booth activities which attracted many kindergarten students and local residents.
- c. On 28th February, during the "Spring Greeting Carnival" hosted by Tsuen Wan Trade Association Chu Cheong Kindergarten, our students, Cheng Cheung Chak, Hung Yui Sato, Nguyen Doan Bao Nguyen, Wong Yuk Wah participated in service learning by hosting booth activities. The game references the traditional pot throwing game, which not only retains the fun of traditional folklore, but also incorporates elements such as parent-child interaction. The school took this opportunity to allow our students to serve enthusiastically and share the joy of the Spring Festival with kindergarten children, and also demonstrated their good communication and expression skills.

3. Home-school cooperation

- a. Our school recently participated in 'The Community Chest Charity Clean Up' to foster a caring heart and good hygiene habits among our students. From 9th to 15th February, students performed daily cleaning tasks at home and recorded their efforts to raise funds for The

Community Chest. Thanks to the generous support of our students and parents, we raised a total of \$5,937 for charitable purposes.

- b. The second Incorporated Management Committee (IMC) meeting of this academic year was held on 26th February. During the meeting, the School Manager, Sponsoring Body Managers, and Parent Managers provided valuable feedback on school policies and measures, offering strategic guidance for the school's operations and future development.
