**Circular on the 4<sup>th</sup> 'A Child's View of Sichuan and Hong Kong' Cultural and Arts Exchange Program**

To promote the integration and healthy development of youth in Sichuan and Hong Kong, enhance Hong Kong students' understanding of the nation, and cultivate the spirit of patriotism and love for Hong Kong, our school participated in the 4<sup>th</sup> 'A Child's View of Sichuan and Hong Kong' Cultural and Arts Exchange Program organized by the Hong Kong Federation of Education Workers and the Sichuan-Hong Kong Basic Education Alliance. Through essays or drawings, students from both regions introduced the unique features of Sichuan and Hong Kong, showcasing the cultures of both places. Our students are invited to participate in the award ceremony and exchange activities. The details of the activity are as follows:

Venue	Neijiang City, Sichuan Province
Target	Our School's Award-Winning Students
Expected Activity	Take a plane to Sichuan. Participating in the '2026 5 <sup>th</sup> Sichuan-Hong Kong-Macao Basic Education Exchange Program' and prizes presentation. Our students will visit primary and secondary schools in Neijiang, conduct study tours and research, and engage in exchange activities at three high-tech enterprises in Neijiang (Changchuan Technology, Fullhan Microelectronics, and Huiyu Pharmaceutical). Additionally, they will visit cultural and historical sites, including the Fan Changjiang Memorial Hall in Tianjia Town, Dongxing District, the Zhang Daqian Memorial Hall, the Longchang Gas Field Memorial Hall, and the ancient streets of Neijiang Old Town.

Expenses includes round-trip airfare between Hong Kong and Sichuan, as well as three nights' accommodation in Neijiang City.)</li> <li>➤ Exact schedule is subject to confirmation by the organizers.</li> <li>➤ Once the application is accepted, there is no withdrawal. The paid fee is non-transferable and cannot be converted into other uses.</li> <li>➤ Applicants who quit after payment will be treated as withdrawing from this activity. All fees are non-refundable.</li> </ul>
