**Circular on 'Promoting Chinese Culture Series:
An Exploration into the History and Cultural Heritage in Shanghai'**

In order to enhance students' understanding of Chinese culture, our school has joined the 'Thematic Mainland Exchange Programmes for Primary and Secondary School Students (2025/26)' organized by The Education Bureau. Through this Programme, students can enhance their understanding of the history, culture, custom of the Shanghai, thereby enhancing their sense of national identity. The details of the activity are as follows:

Target	P.4 to P.6 students of our school
Quota	10 participants
Activity summary	Teacher led the students to Shanghai by plane. Students can visit the Shanghai Museum of Arts and Crafts and the Lin Ximing Modern Paper-cut Art Museum, where students can admire masterpieces of modern and contemporary craftsmanship, deepen their understanding of Shanghai's intangible cultural heritage. Tour Gaoqiao Ancient Town, Yu Garden, and the Bund to learn about Shanghai's history, architecture, culture, and custom of Shanghai. Additionally, the group will visit a local primary school for a half-day exchange program, allowing students to experience campus life in Mainland China and gain insights into the national context.

(The original program fee is HK\$3,560 per person, which covers all visit activities, meals, accommodation, transportation, and basic group comprehensive travel insurance.) ➢ Upon acceptance, participants may not withdraw from the tour. The program fee is non-transferable and may not be applied toward any other person or alternative purposes. ➢ Any participant who withdraws after registration will be deemed to have forfeited their place, and no refunds will be issued by the travel agency.
Travel Documents	Hong Kong identity documents, Mainland Return Permit (valid for at least six months), or other valid travel documents.
Remarks	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Parents are kindly requested to complete the reply slip on or before 30th March, 2026 (Monday). If the number of applicants exceeds the quota, a lucky draw will be held to determine the final selection. As such, no payment is required at this stage; further instructions regarding payment arrangements will be provided once the participant list is announced. 2. Students with high attendance in previous school activities or those who have obtained 8,000 or more award points in the 'Outstanding Student Award Scheme 2025' will be given priority in the selection process for this activity. 3. Students who are successfully selected for the activity will have 8000 award points deducted.
