The latest developments in the school

1. This year, the school continued to hold a joint school graduation ceremony with three kindergartens affiliated to the Tsuen Wan Association, namely Chung Loi Kindergarten, Chu Cheong Kindergarten and Yau Kin Fung Kindergarten, which will be held on June 22 at the Kwai Tsing Theatre.
2. The school's 40th anniversary celebration ceremony will be held in the new school year, with a series of celebrations to be rolled out progressively.

School report, March

1. Teachers' professional development
 - a. Our school has been actively promoting the integration of Artificial Intelligence (AI) in teaching and learning. For the upcoming semester, through the 'Quality Education Fund e-Learning Ancillary Facilities Programme,' we have introduced an AI-based language teaching and learning system for the Chinese and English subjects. This system aims to help students enhance their language skills in writing, speaking, reading, and dictation. To ensure effective implementation, our teachers attended a dedicated workshop on 18th March to learn how to utilize the system to further boost teaching and learning efficacy.
 - b. From 25th to 28th March, Mr. Lai Ki Wa and Ms. Wong Tsz Kwan participated in a study tour to Guizhou. During the trip, they visited several major national historical and cultural sites, including Jiaxiu Pavilion, the 'China Sky Eye' (500-meter Aperture Spherical Radio Telescope, or FAST), and the 'Red Ribbon' Guizhou Great March Cultural Digital Art Museum. They also visited our sister school in Guiyang, the Guanshanhu District Zhishan Middle School (Primary Section).
2. Students' all-round development
 - a. On 3rd March, which coincided with the Lantern Festival, our school held a 'Chinese Traditional Costume Day.' Many students arrived at school dressed in beautiful traditional Chinese attire, taking photos with teachers and classmates to capture the festive spirit. Students also had the opportunity to enjoy glutinous sweet dumplings (Tangyuan), experiencing the joyful atmosphere of the festival firsthand. This event not only heightened students' interest in traditional Chinese festivals but also deepened their understanding and appreciation of Chinese culture.
 - b. On 5th March, the school invited the Neighbourhood Kids Puppet Theatre to perform for our students. Through lively and engaging puppet stories, messages of individual differences, special needs, and inclusivity were brought into the classroom. The students were captivated by the lifelike puppet characters; through these interactive segments, they learned how to respect and accept those who are different from themselves, understanding that every person is unique and valuable. Throughout the performance, the students were highly engaged and responded with great enthusiasm.
 - c. On 11th March, the school organized a touring musical titled 'Language Task Force — Genre Attack' for students in Primary 4 to 6. Through a vibrant and lively performance, the musical helped students gain a deeper understanding of the characteristics of various writing genres, including narrative, explanatory, and functional writing, while emphasizing the importance of analyzing writing prompts. The entire musical was a spectacular success, with students fully immersed and enthusiastically participating in the interactive segments.
 - d. On 13th March, a day celebrated by many as Pi Day, Mathematics teachers and Math Ambassadors organized various circle-related fun activities at the indoor playground during recess and lunch breaks. Students from all levels participated together to learn about circles and the mathematical constant Pi.

3. Home-school cooperation

- a. On 6th March, our school held the 'Extraordinary Achievement Celebration Party (I)' to honor students who have demonstrated outstanding performance and remarkable achievements in external competitions, conduct, and academic studies. Over 170 parents attended the event. During the ceremony, in addition to parents joining their children on stage for commemorative photos, there were captivating performances and heartfelt sharing sessions from both parents and teachers. Following the ceremony, awardees, parents, and teachers gathered for a celebratory tea reception, enjoying a joyful afternoon together.
- b. On 19th March, the Parent School Manager and all staff members attended the Tsuen Wan Trade Association Spring Festival Members' Gala. They enjoyed a celebratory banquet alongside the School Supervisor and School Managers. During the dinner, the School Supervisor and Managers engaged in meaningful exchanges and dialogue with both parents and teachers.
- c. On 21st March, the school held an Ocean Park Photography Experience Workshop for students and parents. All participants were highly engaged. By observing and photographing various endangered and non-endangered animals, they not only learned basic photography skills but also gained a deeper understanding of the importance of ecological conservation. Through collaboration in framing shots, discussion, and creation, parents and children further strengthened their communication and rapport. Through these interactions, students were able to improve their photography results and build self-confidence as they prepared for competition, while also enjoying the fun of being a 'KOL' (Key Opinion Leader).
- d. On 28th March, the school arranged for parents and students to visit the 'Joey's Organic Farm' in Ta Kwu Ling, Fanling, for an 'Organic Picking Fun' activity. As one of the events under the 'Health Education Fortnight,' it aimed to strengthen students' awareness of healthy eating and to cultivate healthy dietary habits.
