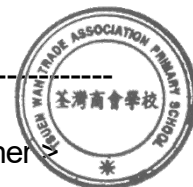

The latest developments in the school

1. During this academic year, our school has established sister-school partnerships with four schools: Denghu Experimental Primary School in Guicheng Subdistrict, Nanhai District, Foshan City, Guangdong Province; Jinggangshan Mao Zedong Red Army School in Ji'an City, Jiangxi Province; Wenlongxiang Primary School in Hangzhou City, Zhejiang Province; and Binhe Primary School in Haibowan District, Wuhai City, Inner Mongolia. Spanning across multiple regions, these four schools each possess unique educational characteristics. Moving forward, we will launch diverse exchange programs, including mutual visiting tours and online cultural studies, to foster mutual learning and joint advancement in education and culture between our regions.
2. The term of the two-year Executive Committee of the Parent-Teacher Association is about to expire. The PTA urgently needs the support and participation of parents to ensure the continued effective development of its affairs. We now call on parents who are interested in serving as new Executive Committee members to seize this opportunity and actively run for office as PTA members, participate in association activities, and work hand in hand with the schools to create a lively and meaningful campus life for your children.

School report, May

1. Teachers' professional development

- a. From 20 to 22nd May, Ms. Wong Lai Lai participated in the Professional Training Course for Special Educational Needs Coordinators. Through action research, she explored how coordinators can fulfill their leadership, coordination, and resource management roles in the process of promoting whole-school inclusive education and optimizing support for SEN students
- b. Congratulations to Mr. Cheung Kwan To on receiving the 'Hong Kong Outstanding Extra-curricular Activities Teacher Commendation Award'. Mr. Cheung attended the award presentation ceremony on 23rd May.

2. Students' all-round development

- a. The Primary 3 PE swimming lessons commenced in May. Our school's physical education curriculum covers eight major learning areas, with swimming being one of them, allowing every student the opportunity to learn this health-enhancing skill. Each year, the school incorporates swimming into the PE curriculum for Primary 3 and Primary 4 students to foster their interest in the sport.
- b. To cultivate students' moral character, the school organized a cross-curricular gratitude activity themed around Mother's Day in early May. The activities included greeting card writing in Chinese and English, gift box making in Mathematics, and song dedications in Music. The Counseling Team specially arranged a 'Hand-painted Tote Bag Workshop', allowing students to personally craft a practical and heartfelt small tote bag. This gift symbolizes a mother's selfless tolerance and love over the years, which, just like a tote bag, gently carries the precious memories and milestones of our growth.
- c. On 15th May, the school held its monthly award presentation ceremony, presenting numerous external awards and certificates across academic, sports, and arts categories. Teachers and students joined together to congratulate the awardees, bringing great joy and gratification to the teachers who have nurtured their growth.

3. Home-school cooperation

- a. On 16th May, our school's Parent-Teacher Association organized an AI Drawing Parent-Child Learning Activity and the 'Joy of Family Learning' Seminar. The event helped parents understand how AI can aid their children's future development, while giving children hands-on experience in the workshop to explore the fun of AI. For the parents' seminar, the association invited Mr. Leung San Man ('Daddy Chan Man'), Director of the Positive Parenting

Academy and a positive education expert, to host a talk on positive parenting. Through his warm and insightful sharing, Daddy Chan Man encouraged parents to nurture their children with respect, appreciation, and encouragement.

- b. To prepare for student lunch arrangements for the 2026-2027 school year, the school previously held a lunch provider briefing and food tasting session, inviting three lunch providers to participate. As an 'EatSmart School' certified by the Department of Health, the school not only considers the service quality, hygiene, and pricing of each provider but also attaches great importance to well-balanced nutrition. On 19th May, the school invited the PTA Chairman, Executive Committee members, class parent representatives, student representatives, and teacher representatives to attend, listen to the providers' presentations, score the student lunches after tasting them, and provide feedback to the school.
- c. On 23rd May, the school organized the 'Early Childhood Decathlon Games Day and 3-on-3 Football Tournament 2026', with many parents bringing their children to the school to participate. The school is committed to fostering students' interest in sports, hoping that children will develop a good habit of loving sports from an early age. Apart from strengthening the body, regular exercise and participating in sports competitions can also enhance children's self-confidence and promote mental well-being. Parents expressed high appreciation for the arrangements of the event.
