

Dear Parents,

Circular on Influenza Cases at school and related prevention measures

We have recently been informed by parents that students in certain classes have successively been infected with influenza or have been showing persistent symptoms such as fever, cough, runny nose, and sore throat. To safeguard the health of all students and staff and to prevent the spread of influenza on campus, our school has activated its infectious disease response mechanism and reported the relevant influenza cases to the Centre for Health Protection (CHP) of the Department of Health. The CHP has also set up a dedicated monitoring team to closely follow up on the health status of our students from 14th to 24th June.

To effectively prevent and control the spread of infectious diseases within the school, we have reminded all staff and students to maintain personal and campus hygiene. The school will also continue to carry out routine cleaning and disinfection of the school premises, using a 1:49 diluted bleach solution to clean classrooms. We earnestly request all parents to remain vigilant against infectious diseases, closely monitor your children's health conditions, and in addition to maintaining a clean and hygienic home environment, please remind your children to pay attention to personal and campus hygiene and to follow the preventive measures below:

1. If a student develops a fever (oral temperature above 37.5°C or ear temperature above 38°C), regardless of whether they have respiratory symptoms, student should stay home to rest and seek medical attention promptly. They should not return to school until at least two days after the fever has subsided.
2. Remind students to wash their hands frequently, especially before eating, after using the toilet, or when their hands are contaminated with respiratory secretions. Hands must be thoroughly cleaned.
3. If a student is confirmed to have influenza, please contact school to report the absence and provide the relevant medical certificate.
4. It is recommended that parents prepare hand sanitizer for their children to use at school when needed.
5. Please arrange for your child to bring a face mask to school every day. If they develop any respiratory symptoms, they must wear a mask immediately.

Furthermore, parents are advised to pay close attention to any changes in their children's physical condition. If you notice fever or flu-related symptoms, please seek medical attention promptly and do not send your child to school. If a student is found to have a fever or flu-like symptoms during school hours, the school will notify the parents and request them to pick up the student from school.
