The latest developments in the school

1. With the Education Bureau announcing the blueprint for digital education in primary and secondary schools, we now have a clearer direction. Our school is planning to join a project from The Education University of Hong Kong to introduce embodied intelligent robots and apply them in classroom teaching.
2. During the summer holidays, the school will undergo multiple renovation projects and optimize learning facilities to prepare well for the new school year.
3. After the tender, a new school bus supplier will provide pick-up and drop-off services for students in the new school year.

School report, June

1. Teachers' professional development

- a. During Saturdays in May and June, Mr Lee Sheung Lok participated in a professional development course for teachers organized by The Education University of Hong Kong, titled "Interdisciplinary Teaching, Curriculum Collaboration, and Innovative Leadership Skills." The course deepened teachers' understanding of the knowledge and skills required to lead and sustain innovation in an educational environment. Topics included an introduction to educational collaboration and innovation, exploring collaborative models that promote innovation and improvement, strategies for effective collaborative leadership, designing change initiatives and innovations, as well as evaluation and continuous improvement. This will be highly beneficial to the school's future curriculum development.
- b. From 18th to 20th June, the Principal led Ms Leung Sze Nga and Ms Chan Lee to participate in the exchange and sister school signing ceremony titled 'Jiangxi and Hong Kong as One Family: My Trip to Jinggangshan — Hong Kong Principals' Delegation to Jiangxi.' A sister school agreement was signed with Jinggangshan Mao Zedong Red Army School in Ji'an City, Jiangxi Province, paving the way for future exchange activities between the two schools. In addition, the Principal, Director Leung, and Ms. Chan visited Jinggangshan Primary School and Ganzhou No. 3 Middle School. They also took part in a wreath-laying ceremony at the Beishan Revolutionary Martyrs Cemetery to pay tribute to the revolutionary martyrs, and conducted educational study tours at the Former Residence of Mao Zedong in Dajing, the Jinggangshan Revolutionary Museum, the Jiangnan Song Dynasty Walled City, and the Ganzhou Museum.

2. Students' all-round development

- a. On 1st June, International Children's Day, the school held the 'Celebrating 1st June Children's Day & Primary-Kindergarten Art and Cultural Exchange' with Tivoli Kindergarten. Students from both our school and Tivoli Kindergarten performed together in the school hall, observing and learning from one another. The school also arranged for robots to lead students in dancing in the indoor playground, and organized various physical game activities to promote the children's physical and mental health through active participation.
- b. To enhance students' knowledge of the environment and nature conservation, the school was invited by Ocean Park to arrange for students to participate in the Ocean Park Summer Adventure learning activity on 13th June. Students observed dolphins at close range while actively participating in various challenges, including interviewing passers-by about dolphin facts and making dolphin-themed souvenirs. Every student was highly engaged and thoroughly enjoyed themselves! Through these enriching group activities, students also learned the importance of teamwork.
- c. To allow students to showcase their talents and build self-confidence, the school held the 'Training Classes Grand Showcase' on 17th June, giving students the opportunity to step onto the stage and present their learning achievements from various sports and arts training classes to teachers and peers. Performance items included rope skipping, Chinese dance, breakdancing, aesthetic gymnastics, fencing, skateboarding, choir, handbells, ukulele, and drum kit performances. Both teachers and students were fully engrossed in watching the showcase, appreciating the hard work put in by the students and offering warm applause as
